선생님



Standard, respectful title for teachers and doctors.

쌤



Friendly and cute slang for tutors or close teachers.

교수님



Specifically used for university professors.

사범님



Title for martial arts (Taekwondo) masters.

선생



Informal or distant form. Use with caution!

"대박" CHEAT SHEET

5 Real Korean Reactions

STANDARD

- 대박! (Daebak!)
- "Awesome!" (When you're excited)

ULTIMATE SHOCK

- 헐 대박! (Heol Daebak!)
- "OMG, no way!" (When you're shocked)

SINCERE COMPLIMENT

- 진짜 대박! (Jinjja Daebak!)
- "Seriously amazing!" (When you're impressed)

YOUTHFUL ENERGY

- 완전 대박! (Wanjeon Daebak!)
- "Totally cool!" (When you're super hyped)

BIG NEWS

- 대박 사건! (Daebak Sageon!)
- "You won't believe this!" (For big announcements)

K-pop & Idols

애교 (AEGYO)

Acting cute or adorable



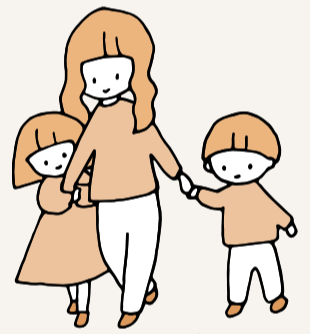
오빠 (OPPA)

Older brother / Older male friend



언니 (UNNIE)

Older sister / Older female friend



대박 (DAEBAK)

Amazing, Awesome, or Fantastic



동생 (DONGSAENG)

Younger brother or sister



CUTE KOREAN WORDS

Love & Romance

사랑해 (SARANGHAE)

I love you



자기야 (JAGIYA)

Honey, Darling, or Baby



여보 (YEOBO)

Darling (Exclusively between married couples)



내꺼 (NAEKKEO)

You are mine / My sweetheart



뽀뽀 (BBO BBO)

A light kiss or peck on the cheek



CUTE KOREAN WORDS

Daily Feelings

정 (JEONG)



Deep affection, warmth, or attachment

귀여워 (GWIYEOWO)



So cute, lovely, or adorable

반짝반짝 (BANJJAK BANJJAK)



Sparkling, twinkling, or shiny

짝꿍 (JJAGKKOONG)



Partner, buddy, or seatmate

빨리 빨리 (PPALLI PPALLI)



Hurry up! / Quickly (used playfully)

먹다 CHEAT SHEET

How to Say "Eat" in Korean

CORE MEANING

- 먹다 (Meok-dda)
- "To eat in Korean" | The ultimate standard form

BASIC CONJUGATION

- Present (현재)
먹어요 | Polite & friendly
- Past (과거)
먹었어요 | "I ate"
- Future (미래)
먹을 거예요 | "I will eat"



WATCH OUT!

- Honorific Form (높임말)
드시다 | Use for elders, formal settings
- Drinking Water (물 먹다)
물 먹었어요 | accepted in daily speech

FUN IDIOMATIC EXPRESSIONS

- 욱을 먹다
Literally: Eat insults → Get scolded
- 맘 먹다
Literally: Eat mind → Decide, Resolve

YOUNGER SISTER

How to Use It Right

STANDARD WORD

- 여동생 (yeo-dong-saeng)
- 여 (yeo): Female
- 동생 (dong-saeng): Younger sibling
- Used by both brothers and sisters!

CASUAL WAY

- 동생 (dong-saeng)
- Usually drop the "여" (female).
- Use when context is clear.

THE #1 MISTAKE!

- Don't say "여동생" to her face.
- ❌ "여동생, 잘 잤어?" (Wrong)
- ✅ Use her Name! (Right)

TALKING ABOUT HER

- Use it to refer to her.
 1. When introducing her.
 2. When writing about her.

SAJANGNIM (사장님)

How to use "Boss" in Korean

WORD BREAKDOWN

- 사 = Company
- 장 = Head, Leader
- 님 = Polite Suffix
- Meaning: Respected head of a company

IN THE OFFICE

- CEO / President / Boss
- For small to medium companies.
- (Note: Larger corporations use Daepyonim 대표님)



AT RESTAURANTS & SHOPS

- Owner / Manager
- Polite way to call a store or restaurant owner.
- Call them "Sajangnim!" for great service!
