

# 5 WAYS TO SAY GOODBYE

## For Every Situation

### 안녕히 가세요



- "Go peacefully."
- Use when you stay and they leave.

### 안녕히 계세요



- "Stay peacefully."
- Use when you leave and they stay.

### 조심히 가세요



- "Go safely / Take care."
- Perfect for elders leaving.

### 들어가세요



- "Please go inside."
- Great for hanging up

### 다음에 또 봐!



- "See you next time!"
- For close friends and classmates.

# HOW TO USE 주세요요

## 5 Essential Expressions

### ITEM

물 주세요요 (Water, please)



### HELP

도와주세요요 (Help me, please)



### SPEED

빨리 주세요요 (Hurry, please)



### GUIDE

가르쳐 주세요요 (Teach me, please)



### NUMBER

하나 주세요요 (One, please)



# 물어보다 CHEAT SHEET

## How to Ask in Korean

### 묻다 VS 물어보다

- 묻다 (Mut-dda)  
"To ask" (Formal / Written language)
- 물어보다 (Mu-reo-bo-da)  
"To try asking" (Softer / Daily speech)

### BASIC TENSES

- Present (현재)  
물어봐요 | "I'm asking"
- Past (과거)  
물어봤어요 | "I asked"
- Future (미래)  
물어볼 거예요 | "I'll ask"



### WATCH OUT!

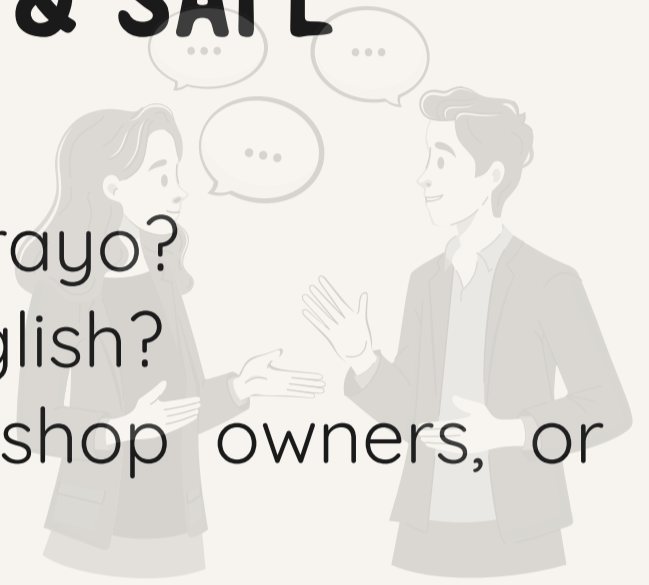
- 물어요 (Mureoyo)  
From 묻다 (To ask) | Not 물어보다
- 물다 (Mulda)  
"To bite" | Watch your pronunciation!

# DO YOU SPEAK ENGLISH?

## How to Ask in Korean

### STANDARD & SAFE

- 영어 할 줄 알아요?
- yeongeο hal jul arayo?
- Do you speak English?
- (For hotel staff, shop owners, or strangers)



### EXTRA POLITE

- 혹시 영어 하실 수 있으세요?
- hoksi yeongeο hasil su isseuseyo?
- By any chance, can you speak English?
- (For elders or formal situations)

### CASUAL & FRIENDS

- 영어 해?
- yeongeο hae?
- Do you speak English?
- (Only for close friends or younger people)



# 마음에 들다

## MEANING

How to say "I like it"

### LITERAL MEANING

- Entered My Heart
- 마음 (Heart) + 들다 (To Enter).
- Something perfectly suits your personal taste.

### REAL NUANCE



- Emotional "Click"
- Used when something matches your vibe instantly.
- More thoughtful and warm than '좋아하다'.

### REAL EXAMPLE

- 이 집이 마음에 들어요.(I like this house / This house suits my taste.)

# 3 WAYS TO SAY "I SEE"

## In Korean Conversations

### 그렇구나!

- Casual (반말)
- "Ah, I get it now!"
- For close friends & younger people



### 그렇군요!

- Polite (존댓말)
- "Oh, I see. I understand."
- For teachers, bosses & strangers



### 알겠습니다.

- Formal (습니다체)
- "Understood. (Professional & Firm)"
- For workplaces, emails & instructions
